

## Moving In Day

The big day is almost here! You'll want to make sure it goes without a hitch. So we've put together a quick rundown of where to go and what to bring. From dedicated moving in times to what you'll need to pack – the details are here. Hopefully, it'll help make your move into Varsity House as easy and smooth as possible.



### Your new home

Your new address will be:

### Moving in dates and times

To keep waiting time to a minimum, we've given you a set date and time to arrive:

**Saturday 11th September** - 10am to 5pm  
**Sunday 12th September** - 10am to 5pm  
**Any weekday from 13th September** - 10am to 4pm

To minimise time spent waiting in a queue and general congestion when you are moving in the accommodation office will contact you and give an allocated time slot and date to move in. Please try to adhere to the time given, if you do have any problems please contact the accommodation office.



### Where you need to go

Please come to the accommodation office – just follow the signs.



### Where to park

Varsity House has very limited parking. Parking on site is limited to 15 minutes in order to unload your belongings. You will then need to move your vehicle to nearby street parking where available.



### Your moving in checklist

Before we can hand over your key, you'll need to have:

- Paid your 1st rent instalment (or full rent if applicable) and your £600 booking fee. Ensure you have the funds available if you have selected to pay by Direct Debit or Card transaction
- Shown the accommodation team your ID (a passport or a driving licence is perfect).

With your key you'll also receive:

- Information about your deposit
- Information about your Tenancy Agreement



- Your Accommodation Guide, featuring lots of useful information to help you settle in to your new home
- Inventory – please check, sign and return to reception within 7 days, thank you.



## What to bring

To ensure you've got all your home comforts, here's a quick rundown of what you'll need to bring:



### Bedding (Single beds)

- Waterproof mattress cover
- Duvet/cover and sheets
- Pillows/pillow cases



### Kitchen utensils

- Pots and pans
- Cutlery
- Plates, bowls, mugs
- Toaster
- Iron/ironing Board
- Washing-up liquid

If you are not going to be living in a studio, why not purchase some of these items with your new flatmates to avoid having too many! You could chat about it on your accommodation Facebook page!



### Bathroom

- Towels
- Toilet roll
- Soap/toiletries



### Other bits and bobs

- TV licence (if applicable)
- Food/drink

It may be a good idea to use your local supermarket when you arrive, or you could order online and get your food and drink delivered. You may like to do this with your new housemates, so have a chat about it on Facebook!
